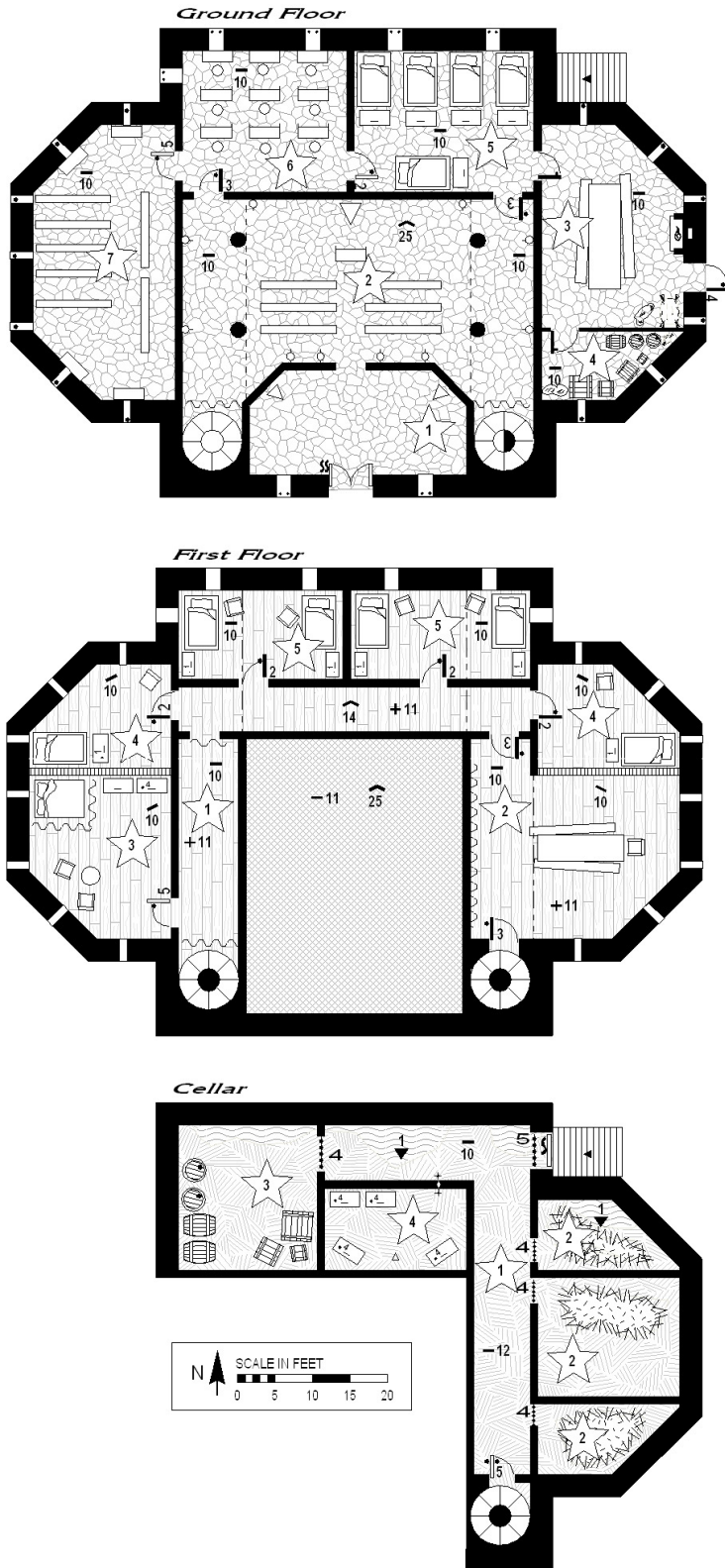


## TEMPLE OF ILVIR [15]



### Ground Floor

#### [1] Porch

The porch is lit by two windows in the southwall. The left statue shows seafarer Ibenis, the right one a serpent.

#### [2] Temple

The temple has a height of 25 feet and is only illuminated by constant burning torches, what intensifies the dark ambience. Just ten or twelve adherents (seldom more) visit the church service. In fall, when the pilgrims start their journey to Araka-Kalai, the temple is too small for all adherents and they have to worship outdoor in the inner courtyard.

#### [3] Kitchen

The meals for priests and acolytes are prepared here. The latter also eat here; the priests dine mostly in the conference chamber in the first floor. The cook, Tarn von Doritta is nearly always present. Because he has no official assistant, he's helped by one or two acolytes. The door in the eastwall is always locked when Tam stays not on the kitchen.

#### [4] Pantry

The provision of the temple is stored here. Despite the fact that the temple is quite wealthy the meals are relative spartan.

#### [5] Dormitory of the acolytes

This room houses the novices of the order. Only three beds are currently occupied. Pilgrims, wanderers and other travellers are also quartered here. Beds and other furniture are very poor but clean.

#### [6] Working room

This room is used for the manufacture of holy writs as well as for other works and for instructions of the novices which are held by one of the five priests. The room is well lit by the windows in the northwall.

#### [7] Library

The library of the order of Seafarer Ibenis is very rich and well sorted. In the last twenty years a huge amount gained by the sale of Ivashi was invested in the purchase and search of holy writs. Most works are about the religion of Ilvir. Works that are about other religions are less represented. If so, they are always about their relation to Ilvir.

### First floor

#### [1] Corridor

This corridor has no windows and is therefor lit by burning torches.

#### [2] Conference chamber

Conferences are held here as well as the meals of the priesthood. On the westwall hangs a recently purchased tapestry depicting Ilvirs Pit including Seafarer Ibenis. It is easy to see that it is very new as well as very expensive.

## **[3] Chamber of the Grandmaster**

Onzar von Suryl is the current Grandmaster of the order Seafarer Ibenis. He stores some personal property in his chests but nothing is of value. However, the chest has a good lock. Things of great value are stored in the basement. (See Cellar (4)) Onzar rarely closes his chamber.

## **[4] Chambers of the priests**

Like Onzar his five priests don't possess anything worth to steal. Currently all priests are in Shiran. The west chamber is occupied by Undil of Corphen, the east chamber is uninhabited.

## **[5] Chambers of the priests**

Not all priests have a chamber for their own like Undil does. The west chamber is inhabited by Dova of Tersebel and Arten of Tharadin; the east one by Orfin of Airnis and Eradah of Galbern. None of the priests owns anything of value. Solely their clothing is a little bit pricy what is very uncommon for priests of Ilvir.

## **Cellar**

### **[1] Corridor**

The floor consists of packed earth which is very soggy in fall. Main cause for this fact is the Undercut of the north-side of the town. Due to the water and the captured Ivashi kept in the cellar cells many bugs inhabit the cellar rooms also.

By moving a single stone in the southwall of the northerly corridor one can gain access to the secret chamber (4).

This mechanism can only be found by intensive inspection of the whole corridor and a successful roll against half awareness.

The door to the external stairs is closed by a wooden crossbar and a iron gate day and night. It is only opened when new Ivashi arrive at the temple. Onzar has the only key to this gate.

### **[2] Ivashucells**

Bought and hunted Ivashi are held here. They are sold to the agrikan order of the Octagonal Pit later. Currently there's only a young Nolah in the middle cell. The north cell isn't used (if possible) because of the groundwater. Onzar has the only key which opens all cells.

### **[3] Storage**

This clammy and frowsty room is in a very bad condition and groundwater has found a way to enter also. The order stores provisions for the Ivashi in the southern part to avoid a deterioration of the fodder. This room needs immediate repair. Tents for pilgrims are also stored here.

### **[4] Seceret chamber**

Here Onzar stores the income of the profitable sell of Ivashi. In total, 2254d can be found here which should be used for renovation of the courtyard.

Holy relics and ritual objects for ceremonies are stored here also. There's no special safeguard. The secret door can be opened from inside by a simple push.
